

Article 3 of the Articles of Association of Society Felix Meritis (Stichting Genootschap Felix Meritis/Felix Meritis Foundation), as last amended on 14 June 2023

Objectives.

1. The objectives of the Foundation are:

- a. to (cause to) stimulate and strengthen relationships between arts, education, media, sciences and commerce;
- b. developing and producing (or having developed and produced) activities in which these relationships are expressed;
- c. owning, renting or otherwise acquiring a location to perform the aforementioned activities;
- d. operating the aforementioned location by means of (sub)lease, catering operations or otherwise;
- e. to continue the activities of the -dissolved- Belgian legal entity: European House for Culture, then based in Brussels (Belgium).

These activities are:

- facilitate the representation of the European cultural field in international structures, especially vis-à-vis supranational governments, but also vis-à-vis all international organisations that may have an interest in culture.
 - strengthen synergies within the cultural sector with the ultimate aim of giving it new dynamics, maximizing its operational results, strengthening its influence at the political level and opening the dialogue with other sectors and European citizens.
 - develop initiatives to improve the quality of cultural activities in Europe that are mainly situated in educational and research projects.
 - bring together various artistic and cultural initiatives and pool efforts within the objectives and policies of the European House for Culture.
 - undertake all other initiatives and actions that are in the spirit of the foundation and that are necessary and useful to optimise the foundation's activities in all possible ways.
- f. everything that belongs to, is related to or may be conducive to the foregoing, all in the broadest sense.

2. The objective of the Foundation is explicitly not to gain profits.
